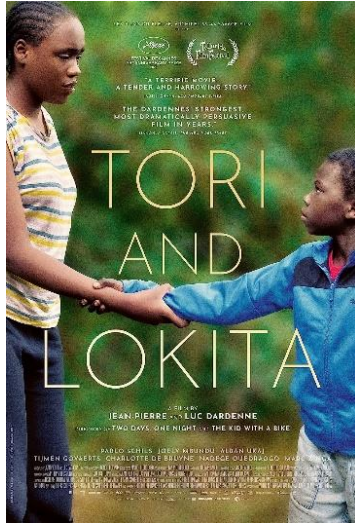

Tori and Lokita (2022) by Dardenne Brothers

Original French version with English subtitles

The movie depicts multiple forms of strong asymmetrical dependencies connected to migration from Africa to Europe. Two young refugees from Benin form a makeshift safety net for one another in the absence of blood relatives while they are facing marginalization, coerced labor, child labor, sexual exploitation, criminalization and further forms of oppression in Belgium.

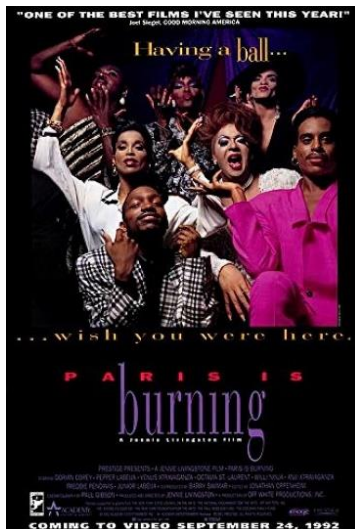

Documenting the queer “Ballroom Culture” in New York City in the 1980s, this groundbreaking movie depicts Latino and African-American gay and transgender communities. It explores their struggles with multiple discrimination regarding their race, class, gender, sexual identity long before concepts such as gender fluidity or intersectionality were discussed in society.
